

Council Meeting Summary - May 11, 2021

This is a summary of some key items from the May 11, 2021 meetings.

Joint Meeting with Deer Park's Council:

1. Bibles for Grade 3 and 4 children were blessed at the May 9 service. A drive-through presentation is being planned.
2. Amalgamation Steering Committee - A report on the work to date of the ASC will be distributed to both communities of faith by early June for review, questions and comments. Feedback sessions will follow.
3. DPUC Interim Supply Minister - June 30 is Tom Melvin's last day. DPUC has hired Cindy Christie-Brooks as an interim supply minister. She is a ministry candidate, has led the CQC ministry and has worked at Forest Lawn UC. She has been hired full-time beginning July 1 for one year.

St. Andrew's Meeting:

1. Financial Update – as of March 31, 2021
St. Andrew's budgeting runs from July 1 to June 30. As of the end of March, SAUC had a 9-month surplus of \$59,416.00. March donations were as expected but revenues continue higher than budgeted due to some large annual donations in the first part of 2021 and the various Covid-19 programs offered by the provincial and federal governments. The surplus is expected to decrease over the rest of the budget year.

July 2021 to June 2022 budget

A congregational meeting to approve the July 2021 to June 2022 budget is being planned for Sunday June 13.
