Leaders are responsible and required to supervise children and daily activities. They will report to the Camp Caravan Senior Counsellor, Coordinator and/or the Children and Family Minister.

Camp Caravan Leader will:

- Provide a fun, safe, and healthy environment for children registered in Summer Day Camp
- Provide supervision and facilitate daily activities
- Work alongside other Camp Caravan staff
- Plan and implement all aspects of the daily schedule within the provided curriculum, and encourage camper participation
- Demonstrate and role model positive behaviour when working with other staff and campers
- Provide first aid when required

- Greet parents and campers on arrival and departure from camp and provide extra assistance as needed
- Attend mandatory staff training prior to camp and all weekly staff meetings

- Strong communication and teamwork skills
- Self motivated, ability to work independently and in team
- Previous day camp or overnight camp experience preferred
- Musical and/or Drama background is an asset
